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## WHITE WINES

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| <b>101. Sancerre Tradition Blanc Domaine Balland France</b><br>Clear to the eye with a pale yellow hue, suggesting a ripe fruity wine, delicate on the nose with aromas of peach and white blossoms then a fresh and supple approach opens out into a rich fruitiness, flavoured with a hint of exotic fruits. | <b>£60.00</b> |
| <b>102. Pouilly–Vinzelles, Louis Latour France</b><br>The nose is floral with a lot of freshness. The generous mouth reveals aromas of white flowers and fresh hazelnuts.  | <b>£46.00</b> |
| <b>103. Macon Lugny, Louis Latour France</b><br>Pleasant aromas of mirabelle plums are revealed on the nose and in the mouth. This wine is rich with a long finish.  | <b>£43.00</b> |
| <b>104. Chablis Domaine-Fevre France</b><br>The rich and complex nose is characterized by pleasant and subtle floral and mineral aromas. It has a wonderful structure in the mouth with minerality and the charming, typical Chardonnay aromas.  | <b>£55.00</b> |
| <b>105. Muscadet Chateau du Cleray Sur Lie France</b><br>Dry, crisp white wine with fresh lemon flavours and a zesty character.  | <b>£30.00</b> |
| <b>106. Kleinkloof Sauvignon Blanc South Africa</b><br>A hint of ripe gooseberry, green apple and citrus has a uplifting intensity.  | <b>£30.00</b> |
| <b>107. Rag &amp; Bone Riesling Australia</b><br>Just a cracking Eden Vally Riesling. Dry textural, limey everything you want from an Aussie Riesling. It finishes lean, fresh linear, crisp.  | <b>£35.00</b> |
| <b>108. Boschendal Grand Cuvee Sauvignon Blanc South Africa</b><br>These complex flavours carry through to the creamy, harmonious palate adding to the mineral zesty finish.   | <b>£36.00</b> |
| <b>109. Pouilly Fuisse Naudin Doudet France</b><br>This Pouilly Fuissie, white Burgundy with its richness texture and toasted flavour.   | <b>£65.00</b> |
| <b>110. Allan Scott Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand</b><br>Fresh citrus and nettles with hits of passionfruit on the nose. The citrus and passionfruit follows through to the palate with hints of dried herbs.  | <b>£47.00</b> |
| <b>111. Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand</b><br>Zesty and aromatic with lots of lively fruit characters.   | <b>£32.00</b> |
| <b>112. Bogle Chardonnay America</b><br>Classic Clarksburg personality shines through in the green apple and pear notes, while a bit more tropical pineapple breezes by.   | <b>£62.00</b> |
| <b>114. Gavi Di Gavi Italy</b><br>Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is a particularly characterful Gavi.   | <b>£40.00</b> |
| <b>115. Pinot Grigio Italy</b><br>“Villa Cornaro” offers an exquisite, soft exotic fruit, well balanced.   | <b>£30.00</b> |
| <b>116. Falanghina Terranera DOC Italy</b><br>Better known for its citrus blossom aromas, in particular bitter orange. On the palate it typically shows apple and pear flavour.  | <b>£35.00</b> |
| <b>118. Tributo Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, Leyda Valley Chile</b><br>A great Sauvignon with an intense aroma of limes and grapefruit that follow through to a palate that is bursting with fresh green fruit flavours and crisp citrus.  | <b>£42.00</b> |

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| <b>201. Sancerre, Domaine du Pré Semelé France</b><br>A well-balanced, vinous rosé. Raspberry pink, this delicious rosé has fresh, fruity melon aromas. The palate is mineral, clean and impeccably balanced with flavours of redcurrants and a bright, crisp finish. | <b>£42.00</b> |
| <b>202. Mirabeau Azure, Côtes de Provence France</b><br>An elegant pale peach rosé. Generous in the mouth, ample and round, but its tense acidity provides balance. Notes of dried apricot and lime make for a moreish and refreshing finish.                         | <b>£45.00</b> |

## RED WINES

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| <b>301. Château Lucas Lussac Saint Emilion France</b><br>Lots of fruit from the plummy Merlot to blackberry from the Cabernet and a hint of dark chocolate on the nose.  | <b>£42.00</b>  |
| <b>302. Lacoste-Borie Pauillac France</b><br>Beautiful ruby red colour, very intense red berry aromas and spicy notes, it presents a very characteristic cassis nose. Fruity with ripe and silky tannins on the palate.  | <b>£102.00</b> |
| <b>303. Chateau Les Hauts de Tetre France</b><br>This lovely wine offers us spicy and fruity notes. An elegant and silky wine, worthy of Margaux wines.  | <b>£75.00</b>  |
| <b>304. Chateau de Pierreux Brouilly France</b><br>Brilliant deep ruby in colour with an elegant aroma of soft, floral notes of violet and peonies. Soft and round on the palate with dark berry flavours of blueberry and blackcurrant.                         | <b>£45.00</b>  |
| <b>305. Château Reynier France</b><br>Generous, ripe and easy drinking giving a roundness and richness to the palate.  | <b>£42.00</b>  |
| <b>306. Côtes du Rhône Rouge Reserve Alain Jaume France</b><br>This wine has a delicious concentration of red berry fruits and a superb soft and rounded aftertaste.   | <b>£40.00</b>  |
| <b>307. Châteauneuf Du-Pape, Les Galets de la Berthaudes France</b><br>This is Châteauneuf full of pretty raspberry and red cherry aromas. Full bodied and rich, it offers a silky texture with flavours of damson, spiced plum and peppery spice on the palate. | <b>£65.00</b>  |
| <b>309. Chateau Pedesclaux Sieme Cru Classe France</b><br>Reflects its complex terroir. Pedesclaux embodies the density of Pauillac tempered by a unique sensuality. Complexity, depth, freshness and tension.   | <b>£135.00</b> |
| <b>310. Fleurie Charles Vienot France</b><br>This is beautifully refreshing and irresistibly moreish modern Beaujolais.  | <b>£39.00</b>  |
| <b>311. Ropiteau Plants Nobles Pinot Noir France</b><br>Ruby red colour, warm-tasting with red fruit bouquet, full bodied with blackcurrant flavours and light spice.  | <b>£36.00</b>  |
| <b>312. McGuigan Signature Shiraz Australia</b><br>Rich dark red in colour with a wonderful bouquet of ripe plum and berry fruits.   | <b>£30.00</b>  |
| <b>313. Allan Scott Marlborough Pinot Noir New Zealand</b><br>On the nose there are ripe red fruits, cassis and delicious spicy notes with hints of tobacco, supported by the well-integrated oak.   | <b>£47.00</b>  |
| <b>314. Malbec, Parlez-Vous France</b><br>A young red fruit on the nose with a structured palate of floral hits, plum and berries.   | <b>£30.00</b>  |

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| <b>315. Rickety Bridge Shiraz South Africa</b><br>Layered with redcurrants and mulberry and subtle hints of spice and white pepper, this wine displays elegance and structure on the palate along with fine supple tannins. | <b>£37.00</b> |
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| <b>316. Boschendal Lanoy Cabernet Merlot South Africa</b><br>A rich, smooth wine with flavours of blackberry, chocolate and spice. | <b>£37.00</b> |
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| <b>317. Bodega Monteveijo Festivo Malbec Argentina</b><br>Bright red with purple glints. Aromas of red fruit such as cherries and raspberries. On the palate it is fresh and has medium length. A balanced wine, fresh and fruity, with excellent varietal typicity. | <b>£48.00</b> |
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| <b>318. Los Haroldos Chacabuco Malbec Argentina</b><br>A nose of plum, damson and black cherry with a hint of spice. | <b>£34.00</b> |
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| <b>319. Oyster Bay Merlot New Zealand</b><br>Glorious flavours of juicy black plum, sweet berry fruits and spice. | <b>£32.00</b> |
