

## CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINES

**061. Dom Perignon** France £195.00

More than strength or richness, there is an intensity, a sensation replete with freshness and firmness, which is remarkable.

**062. Laurent Perrier Rose NV** France £95.00

Made using only Pinot Noir fruit from Grand Cru village, with delicious raspberry and redcurrant fruit flavour.

**063. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label** France £65.00

This wine is quite simply dazzling with its wealth of aromas, and a deliciously long and powerful finish.

**064. House Champagne** France £45.00

Champagne Fluteau, Carte Blanche Brut Made from 100% Pinot Noir this is fruity Champagne that still manages to be crisply elegant.

**065. Louis Bouillot Perle D'Aurore Crémant Rose** France £60.00

A brilliant salmon pink with raspberry and redcurrant which evolves into slightly jammy notes.

**066. Louis Bouillot Perle de Vigne Crémant Grand Reserve** France £55.00

For young and rebellious bubbles! A solid gold robe coupled with a slightly yeasty nose revealing light aromas of toast and fresh pear, and almond and white flower aromas.

**067. Boschendal Pavilion Rose** South Africa £35.00

Sensual salmon in colour, offering diverse and complex flavours from red berries to floral hints.

**068. Prosecco Valdobbiene Casa Rosa** Italy £30.00

A fizzy fruit bombshell. Light-weight and gently aromatic, with crisp, delicate and fresh apple flavours.

**Patio Chardonnay** France £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

Features a generous nose with notes of nectarine. Lovely tropical fruit flavours and a long finish.

**Patio Sauvignon Blanc** France £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

Fresh with notes of grapefruit and pineapple with lovely flavours of citrus and a lively finish.

**Ponte Pinot Grigio** Italy £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

The wine has fruity bouquet, delicate and complex. The palate is dry, very flavoursome with good body and lengthy finish.

## HOUSE RED WINE

**Patio Merlot** France £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

Vivid deep purplish red in colour with notes of blackberry and peppermint.

**Patio Cabernet Sauvignon** France £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

Features an intense nose with notes of blueberry and violet.

**Malbec Kaleu** Argentina £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

A juicy, brambly nose leads to a soft and round palate with redcurrants, blackcurrants and plums. Soft tannins and a nice lift of acidity make this a lovely everyday Malbec.

## HOUSE ROSE WINE

**Patio Rose Grenache** France £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

Delicate on the palate, revealing lovely citrus and red berry flavours.

**Pinot Grigio Blush** Italy £6.30 £8.40 £25.20

This pale blush pink wine has delicate aromas of wild strawberry, apple and honeysuckle. It is crisp and fresh on the palate.

Sancerre Tradition Blanc Domaine Balland</b> Clear to the eye with a pale yellow hue, suggesting a ripe fruity wine, delicate on the nose with aromas of peach and white blossoms then a fresh and supple approach opens out into a rich fruitiness, flavoured with a hint of exotic fruits.	<b>£55.00</b>

<b>108. Boschendal Grand Cuvee Sauvignon Blanc South Africa</b> These complex flavours carry through to the creamy, harmonious palate adding to the mineral zesty finish.	<b>£36.00</b>
<b>109. Pouilly Fuisse Naudin Doudet France</b> This Pouilly Fuissie, white Burgundy with its richness texture and toasted flavour.	<b>£62.00</b>
<b>110. Allan Scott Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand</b> Fresh citrus and nettles with hits of passionfruit on the nose. The citrus and passionfruit follows through to the palate with hints of dried herbs.	<b>£45.00</b>
<b>111. Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand</b> Zesty and aromatic with lots of lively fruit characters.	<b>£32.00</b>
<b>112. Bogle Chardonnay America</b> Classic Clarksburg personality shines through in the green apple and pear notes, while a bit more tropical pineapple breezes by.	<b>£62.00</b>
<b>113. Not your Grandma’s Riesling Eden Valley Australia</b> Floral, lemon/lime and lychee aromas are followed by intense apple, lime and orange blossom on the palate.	<b>£52.00</b>
<b>114. Gavi Di Gavi Italy</b> Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is a particularly characterful Gavi.	<b>£39.00</b>
<b>115. Pinot Grigio Italy</b> “Villa Cornaro” offers an exquisite, soft exotic fruit, well balanced.	<b>£29.00</b>
<b>116. Falanghina Terranera DOC Italy</b> Better known for its citrus blossom aromas, in particular bitter orange. On the palate it typically shows apple and pear flavour.	<b>£33.00</b>
<b>117. Gewurztraminer Reserve Turckheim France</b> A Gewurztraminer wine of great finesse, ripeness and varietal purity, with fragrant rose-petal and grapefruit aromas.	<b>£36.00</b>
<b>118. Tributo Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, Leyda Valley Chile</b> A great Sauvignon with an intense aroma of limes and grapefruit that follow through to a palate that is bursting with fresh green fruit flavours and crisp citrus.	<b>£42.00</b>

## ROSE WINES

<b>201. Discovery Beach, White Zinfandel America</b> Ripe watermelon, appealing strawberry and a hints of dried cranberry, swirl together with a gentle sweetness and a crisp, balanced finish.	<b>£25.00</b>
<b>202. Cotes De Provence Rose Gassier Sables D’Azur France</b> Clean, yet full of the fragrance of fresh fruit. Ends on slightly sharp note, which emphasizes its length.	<b>£31.00</b>

## RED WINES

<b>301. Château Lucas Lussac Saint Emilion France</b> Lots of fruit from the plummy Merlot to blackberry from the Cabernet and a hint of dark chocolate on the nose.	<b>£40.00</b>
<b>302. Chateau Gran Cru Puy Ducasse France</b> Medium bodied, with a crisp, bright red fruit character, crunchy red fruit dominated finish.	<b>£80.00</b>
<b>303. Chateau Siran France</b> The result of a subtle blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot, which reflects the identity of its terroir. The relatively high percentage of Petit Verdot brings a spicy note that reinforces the unique character.	<b>£105.00</b>
<b>304. Chateau de Pierreux Brouilly France</b> Brilliant deep ruby in colour with an elegant aroma of soft, floral notes of violet and peonies. Soft and round on the palate with dark berry flavours of blueberry and blackcurrant.	<b>£45.00</b>
<b>305. Château Reynier France</b> Generous, ripe and easy drinking giving a roundness and richness to the palate.	<b>£42.00</b>
<b>306. Cotes Du Rhone, Leon Perdigal Ogier France</b> The wine displays plenty of rich ripe fruit whilst retaining a good balance.	<b>£30.00</b>
<b>307. Châteauneuf Du-Pape Reine Jeanne Ogier France</b> Deep ruby purple colour. A sweet nose of ripe Grenache along with raspberries, cherries, liquorice.	<b>£47.00</b>
<b>308. Bourgogne Gamay, Louis Latour France</b> Shimmering garnet-red in colour and reveals aromas of violet and quince. It is tasty, round and rich with wild strawberry flavours.	<b>£36.00</b>
<b>309. Chateau Pedesclaux Sieme Cru Classe France</b> Reflects its complex terroir. Pedesclaux embodies the density of Pauillac tempered by a unique sensuality. Complexity, depth, freshness and tension.	<b>£175.00</b>
<b>310. Fleurie Charles Vienot France</b> This is beautifully refreshing and irresistibly moreish modern Beaujolais.	<b>£36.00</b>
<b>311. Ropiteau Plants Nobles Pinot Noir France</b> Ruby red colour, warm-tasting with red fruit bouquet, full bodied with blackcurrant flavours and light spice.	<b>£36.00</b>
<b>312. McGuigan Signature Shiraz Australia</b> Rich dark red in colour with a wonderful bouquet of ripe plum and berry fruits.	<b>£30.00</b>
<b>313. Allan Scott Marlborough Pinot Noir New Zealand</b> On the nose there are ripe red fruits, cassis and delicious spicy notes with hints of tobacco, supported by the well-integrated oak.	<b>£60.00</b>

**315. Rickety Bridge Shiraz South Africa** **£37.00**  
Layered with redcurrants and mulberry and subtle hints of spice and white pepper, this wine displays elegance and structure on the palate along with fine supple tannins.

**316. Boschendal Lanoy Cabernet Merlot South Africa** **£37.00**  
A rich, smooth wine with flavours of blackberry, chocolate and spice.

**317. Bodega Monteveijo Festivo Malbec Argentina** **£45.00**  
Bright red with purple glints. Aromas of red fruit such as cherries and raspberries. On the palate it is fresh and has medium length. A balanced wine, fresh and fruity, with excellent varietal typicity.

**318. Los Haroldos Chacabuco Malbec Argentina** **£34.00**  
A nose of plum, damson and black cherry with a hint of spice.

**319. Oyster Bay Merlot New Zealand** **£32.00**  
Glorious flavours of juicy black plum, sweet berry fruits and spice.

**320. Della Valpolicella Amarone Italy** **£52.00**  
Brilliant and intense ruby red. Complex and rounded, with a powerful structure supporting the fruit and a lovely freshness on the finish.

**321. Chianti Classico Italy** **£31.00**  
Characteristic Chianti flavours of red cherry and bramble. A fruity wine with a rich finish.

**322. Prunus Dao Portugal** **£34.00**  
Lightly oaked the nose is cram-packed with mulberries blackberries and anise.

**323. Cune Rioja Tinto Crianza Spain** **£34.00**  
The palate shows some spicy notes and balanced acidity lead to a nicely savoury finish.

**324. Estacion 1883 Bonarda Argentina** **£48.00**  
This Bonarda exhibits notes of plums and strawberries with smoky tones and hints of liquorice.
