Champagne & Sparkling Wines

- 62. Perrier Jouet** £65.00
An attractive bouquet with youthful, delicate, lively bubbles on the palate with clean, soft, creamy fruit.
- 63. Boschendal Pavilion Rose** £30.00
Sensual salmon in colour, offering diverse and complex flavours from red Berries to floral hints.
- 66. Prosecco Valdobbiane Casa Rosa** £26.95
A fizzy fruit bombshell. Light-weight and gently aromatic, with crisp, delicate and fresh apple flavours.
- 67. Dom Perignon** £190.00
More than strength or richness, there is an intensity, a sensation replete with freshness and firmness, which is remarkable.
- 68. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label** £59.00
This wine is quite simply dazzling with its wealth of aromas, and a deliciously long and powerful finish.
- 69. Laurent Perrier Rose NV** £89.00
Made using only pinot noir fruit from grand cru village, with delicious raspberry and redcurrant fruit flavour.
- 70. House Champagne** £39.00
Champagne Fluteau, Carte Blanche Brut Made from 100% Pinot Noir this is fruity Champagne that still manages to be crisply elegant.

White Wines

- 15. Pouilly–Vinzelles, Louis Latour** £30.95
The nose is floral with a lot of freshness. The generous mouth reveals aromas of white flowers and fresh hazelnuts.
- 16. Macon Lugny, Louis Latour** £29.00
Pleasant aromas of mirabelle plums are revealed on the nose and in the mouth. This wine is rich with a long finish.
- 17. Chablis Charles Vienot** £32.00
A dry crisp taste which distinguishes it from more opulent chardonnays.
- 20. Muscadet Chateau du Cleray Sur Lie** £25.50
Dry, crisp white wine with fresh lemon flavours and a zesty character.
- 24. Kleinkloof Sauvignon Blanc** £29.50
A hint of ripe gooseberry, green apple and citrus has a uplifting intensity.
- 25. Rag & Bone Riesling Australia** £25.50
Just a cracking Eden Vally Riesling. Dry textural, limey everything you want from an Aussie Riesling. It finishes lean, fresh linear, crisp.
- 32. Boschendal Grand Cuvee Sauvignon Blanc South Africa** £32.00
These complex flavours carry through to the creamy, harmonious palate adding to the mineral zesty finish.

37. Pouilly Fuisse Naudin Doudet **£59.00**

This Pouilly Fuissie, white Burgundy with its richness texture and toasted flavour.

38. Cune Monopole Bianco Spain **£26.50**

This unoaked Viura is bright straw yellow with hints of green, followed by aromas of fine citrus and floral, and a touch of grapefruit and orange blossom. The palate shows ripe citrus and mango flavours and a balanced acidity.

39. Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand **£27.50**

Zesty and aromatic with lots of lively fruit characters.

45. Marques de Caceres, Sav Blanc **£32.00**

Intense bouquet of peaches and citrus fruit with a depth of passion fruit.

46. Gavi Di Gavi Italy **£39.00**

Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is a particularly characterful Gavi.

47. Pinot Grigio **£24.50**

"Villa Cornaro" offers an exquisite, soft exotic fruit, well balanced.

52. Gewurztraminer Reserve Turckheim **£32.00**

A Gewurztraminer wine of great finesse, ripeness and varietal purity, with fragrant rose-petal and grapefruit aromas.

Red Wines

1. Château Lucas Lussac Saint Emilion **£36.00**

Lots of fruit from the plummy Merlot to blackberry from the Cabernet and a hint of dark chocolate on the nose.

2. Chateau Gran Cru Puy Ducasse **£75.00**

Medium bodied, with a crisp, bright red fruit character, crunchy red fruit dominated finish

3. Croix De Margaux **£45.00**

On the nose, straightforward dark fruit with some oak followed by toasty notes. The taste is very fruit-forward and fairly concentrated on the palate. Pleasant and not too overpowering tannins despite the relative youth of this wine.

4. Cotes De Beaune Villages Louis Latour **£35.00**

Ruby red colour with garnet-red lights. On the nose, there are aromas of red berries, blackcurrant and strawberry. The mouth is ample with grilled and undergrowth notes and the tannins are present.

5. Château Marsan Bordeaux Superieur **£37.00**

An excellent value Bordeaux, the wine offers rich red fruit on a palate that is supple and round. The silky tannins blend easily with the fruit character and pairs beautifully with dishes like braised lamb or rosemary steak.

8. Cotes Du Rhone, Leon Perdigal Ogier **£26.00**

The wine displays plenty of rich ripe fruit whilst retaining a good balance.

9. Châteauneuf Du-Pape Reine Jeanne Ogier	£42.00
Deep ruby purple colour. A sweet nose of ripe Grenache along with raspberries, cherries, liquorice.	
10. Bourgogne Gamay, Louis Latour	£31.00
Shimmering garnet-red in colour and reveals aromas of violet and quince. It is tasty, round and rich with wild strawberry flavours.	
11. Chateau Les Cruzelles Pomerol	£55.00
Dominated by Merlot with 10% Cabernet Franc, this wine is soft, forward and plummy with an open chocolate- covered, black raspberry finish.	
12. Fleurie Charles Vienot	£32.00
This is beautifully refreshing and irresistibly moreish modern Beaujolais.	
26. McGuigan Signature Shiraz	£27.00
Rich dark red in colour with a wonderful bouquet of ripe plum and berry fruits.	
29. Tempus Two Merlot Sliver Series	£26.00
Voluptuous in the mouth, the tannins are plentiful but soft. The fruit is plump, and tinged in spicy oak.	
30. Malbec France	£27.00
A young red fruit on the nose with a structured palate of floral hits, plum and berries.	
31. Rickety Bridge Shiraz	£33.00
Layered with redcurrants and mulberry and subtle hints of spice and white pepper, this wine displays elegance and structure on the palate along with fine supple tannins.	
33. Boschendal Lanoy Cabernet Merlot South Africa	£33.00
A rich, smooth wine with flavours of blackberry, chocolate and spice.	
36. Etchart Privado Malbec Argentina	£26.00
A rich, yet very soft example of what many regard as Argentina's most successful red grape.	
40. Oyster Bay Merlot New Zealand	£27.50
Glorious flavours of juicy black plum, sweet berry fruits and spice.	
42. Della Valpolicella Amarone Italy	£47.00
Brilliant and intense ruby red. Complex and rounded, with a powerful structure supporting the fruit and a lovely freshness on the finish.	
43. Chianti Classico Italy	£26.00
Characteristic Chianti flavours of red cherry and bramble. A fruity wine with a rich finish.	
49. Cune Rioja Tinto Crianza Spain	£30.00
The palate shows some spicy notes and balanced acidity lead to a nicely savoury finish.	
50. Marques de Caceres Rioja Spain	£31.00
Redefined bouquet of black cherries and blackberries with a soft touch of aromatic Mediterranean herbs.	

28. Sutter home White Zinfandel America **£24.50**

A delicate blush pink colour introduces this fresh, lively wine. On your palate, light creaminess surrenders to a refreshing crisp finish of strawberries and melon.

51. Cotes De Provence Rose Gassier Sables D'Azur **£27.00**

Clean, yet full of the fragrance of fresh fruit. Ends on slightly sharp note, which emphasizes its length.

53. Cabernet Franc Rosé **£26.00**

Cherries, raspberries and strawberries fill the palate whilst the acidity keeps it fresh and on the drier side.

Desert Wine

07. Boschendal Vin 'Or **£24.00**

Tropical pineapple, green apple and raw honey flavours, supported by vanilla spice from fermentation in oak barrels.

6. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label **£35.00**

This wine is quite simply dazzling with its wealth of aromas, and a deliciously long and powerful finish.

8. Cote du Rhone Leon Perdigal Ogier France **£17.00**

The wine displays plenty of rich ripe fruit whilst retaining a good balance.

9. Châteauneuf Du-Pape Reine Jeanne Ogier France **£25.00**

Deep ruby purple colour and a sweet nose of ripe Grenache along with raspberries, cherries, liquorice.

12. Fleurie Charles Vienot France **£22.00**

This is beautifully refreshing and irresistibly moreish modern Beaujolais.

16. Macon Lugny, Louis Latour France **£20.00**

Pleasant aromas of Mirabelle plums are revealed on the nose and in the mouth. This wine is rich with a long finish.

17. Chablis Charles Vienot France **£22.00**

A dry crisp taste which distinguishes it from more opulent chardonnays.

20. Muscadet Chateau du Cleray Sur Lie France **£18.00**

Dry, crisp white wine with fresh lemon flavours and a zesty character.
