

GOING GREEN APPENDIX

Sarnia Hotels are three family owned hotels all based in Guernsey. We value our island heritage and are working to reduce our impact on our environment, reduce our carbon footprint and play our part in the local community.

Hotel de Havelet has been recognised with a Silver Award for Responsible Tourism, celebrating our commitment to sustainable hospitality, energy efficiency, and supporting the local community.

Some of the measures we have introduced so far include:

- All shower heads and water taps are equipped with Ecowaterjet, a water-saving technology that reduces water consumption by up to 40% while maintaining full guest comfort.
- Monitoring our energy and water use
- To reduce single use bottles and save water, we provide guests with refillable glass bottles in their rooms which can be refilled at our two hotel water stations whenever needed.
- Having double or secondary glazing in place in most of the hotel to reduce heat loss
- Using energy saving light bulbs (LED or low energy) in most public areas of the hotel
- 75% of our rooms have Mira eco water saving shower heads
- As most of Guernsey's electricity is supplied by cable from France using greener sources we are moving away as much as possible from Oil and Gas
- 70% of hotel bedrooms are now heated and cooled by electric heat pumps
- In 2024 we installed an array of 60 Photo voltaic panels to generate clean energy and we also improved the roof insulation in the courtyard rooms.
- Our in house laundry is now electric powered rather than gas
- Solar panels help to heat the water in the swimming pool which also uses bromine rather than chlorine which is better for the environment.
- Only leaving essential internal lighting on at night
- Recycle paper, cardboard, tins, plastic bottles, glass, used cooking oil, milk and juice cartons, batteries and printer cartridges
- Using the minimum amount of packaged portion items
- Reusing paper for internal documents and note taking
- Installing refillable dispensers for toiletries which are produced on island using guernsey seaweed – a completely sustainable source
- Introduced Aqueous Ozone cleaning system

- We buy local produce whenever possible and use local trades people and contractors for refurbishing and upgrading
- Our menus include vegetarian and vegan options
- Only running dish washers and glass washers with full load
- We have information on the public bus services and can also arrange cycle hire and have secure cycle storage for guests
- Introduce environmental awareness into our staff induction programme
- The kitchen in Copenhagen grill is all electric and includes induction hobs, rational combi ovens and an energy saving grill.
- Replaced our main boiler with more efficient condensing boilers
- We support the healing Music Trust and junior badminton as well as local schools and charities
- Our vegetable food waste is composted by the Soil Farm
- We collect used stamps and change for action aid and we support the Tumaini fund for orphans in Tanzania
- We support WaterAid with its clean water project by offering Belu water

For the next level

We are constantly looking at ways to increase our sustainable purchasing and supplier screening procedures. We regularly re-visit our recycling options giving preference to measures aimed at eliminating or reducing waste.
